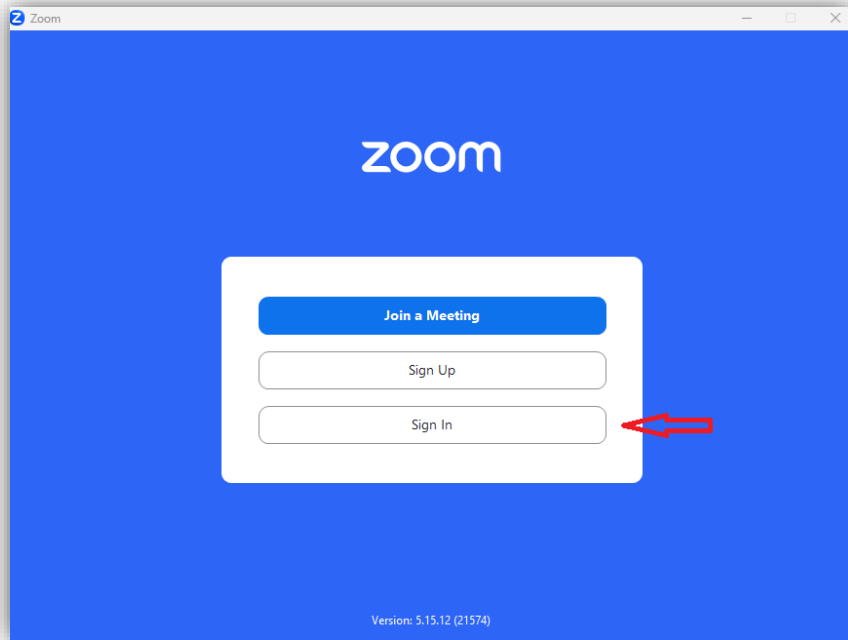
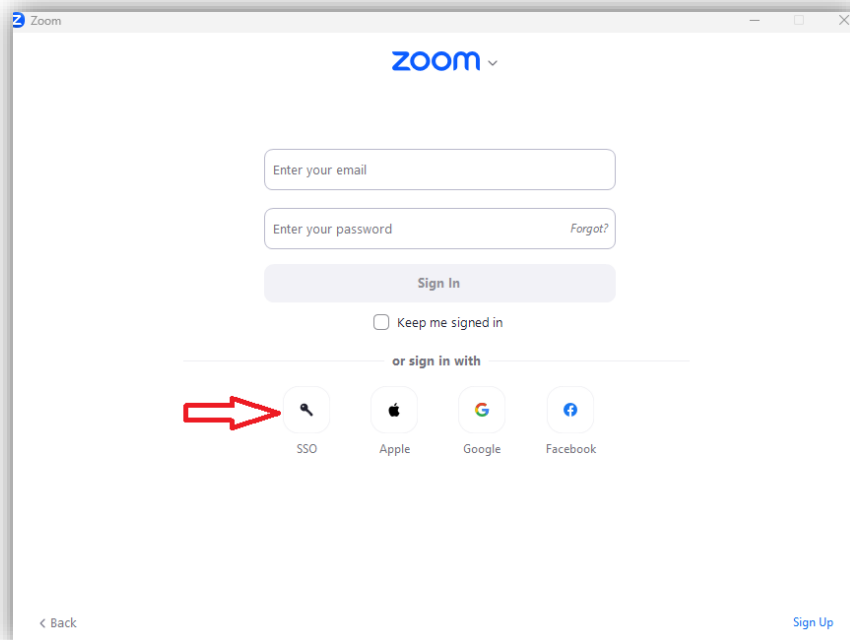


How to open and sign into your zoom phone on your computer


- Navigate to your zoom app on your computer and click on sign in

- Type minnstate in the text box and click on continue



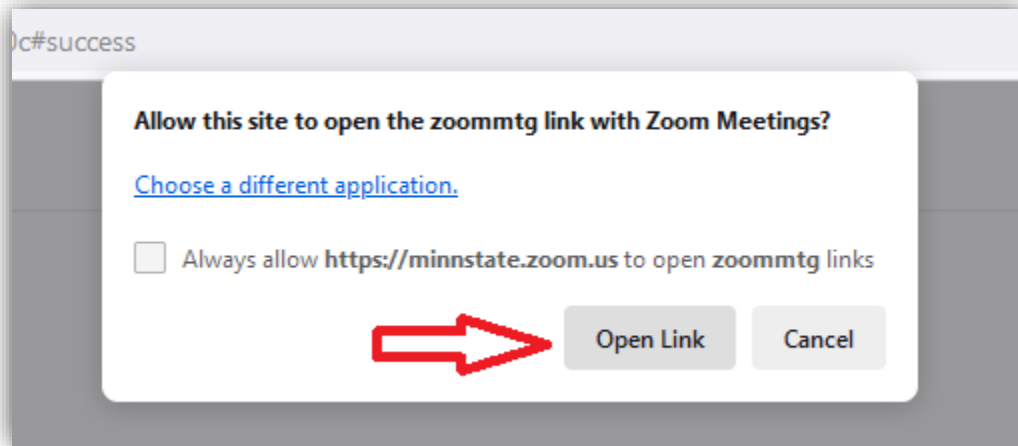
