Instructions on How to Print Wirelessly from Your Laptop to an SMSU Lab, Deeann Griebel Student Success Center, or Library Printer

Note: The wireless printing setup process for Windows 10, Windows 8, and Windows 7 is very similar. The instructions provided below should work for all these operating systems. In case you encounter any difficulties, please don't hesitate to contact the Technology Resource Center for assistance.

- 1) Ensure that your device is connected to the SMSU wireless network.
- 2) Open the Start menu, and in the Search bar, type "\\prtsrv01.smsu.edu" and then press ENTER.
- 3) A login box will appear. Enter your StarID (the same one used for logging into on-campus machines, email, etc.).



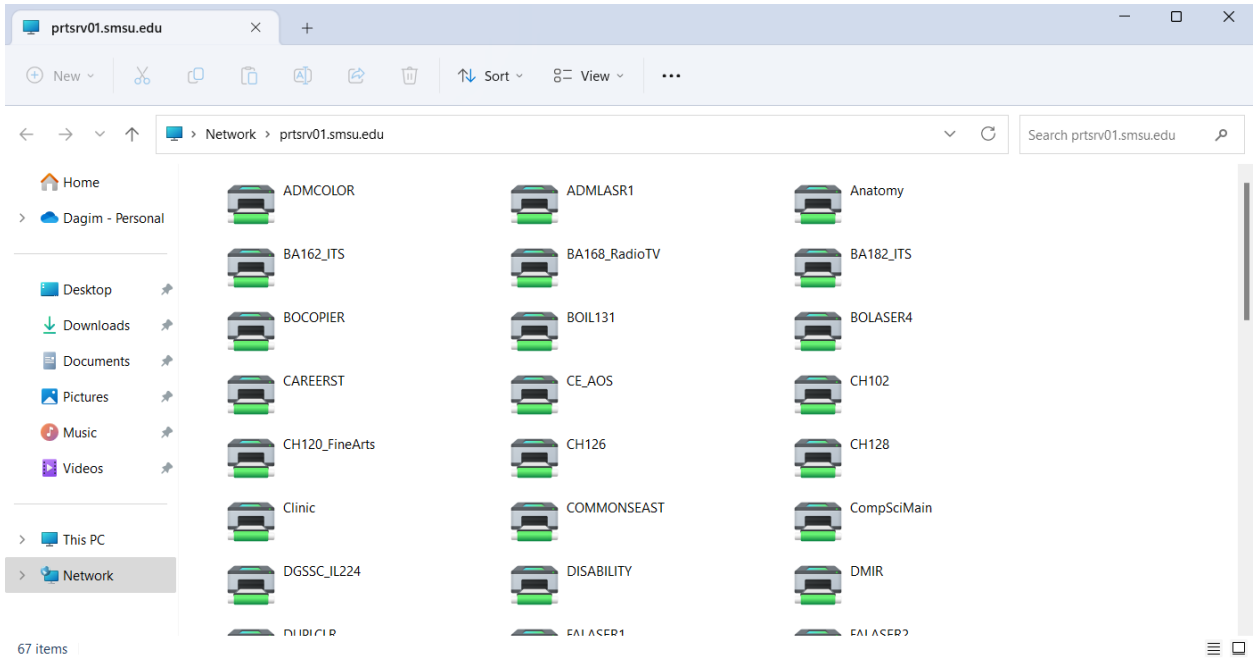
Enter network credentials

- 4) Once you've entered your StarID with the "smsu\" prefix, it will connect to the printer.
